Telangana Becomes First State to Implement SC Sub-Categorisation

Telangana became the <u>first Indian state to enforce Scheduled Castes (SC) sub-categorisation</u>, <u>following Supreme Court approval</u>. Through the Telangana Scheduled Castes (Rationalization of Reservations) Act, 2025, the state restructured its 15% SC reservation by dividing 59 sub-castes into three groups based on backwardness, aiming for fairer benefit distribution.

Delhi IGI Airport Ranked 9th Busiest Globally in 2024

Indira Gandhi International Airport in Delhi has earned the 9th spot among the world's busiest airports for 2024, according to Airports Council International (ACI) World. Handling 77 million passengers, IGI is the only Indian airport in the top 10, highlighting its growing global connectivity and strong infrastructure development.

Banaras Shehnai Granted GI Tag

The <u>Banaras Shehnai has been awarded the Geographical Indication (GI) tag</u>, celebrating its cultural and spiritual significance. Known worldwide through Ustad Bismillah Khan, this recognition honors the traditional artisans of Varanasi and affirms their craftsmanship and cultural heritage.

CPCB Introduces 'Blue Category' for Essential Environmental Services to Boost Pollution Control

The <u>Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB)</u> has introduced a 'Blue Category' for industries involved in essential environmental services (EES), such as <u>waste-to-energy plants</u>, biomining, and <u>compressed biogas plants</u>. These industries will receive extended consent validity as an incentive for their contribution to pollution management. This move aims to streamline pollution control, better regulate these industries, and promote sustainable practices.

Surat's Cap-and-Trade Programme Shows Major Environmental and Economic Success

A study published in *The Quarterly Journal of Economics* has shown that <u>Surat's cap-and-trade programme for particulate matter emissions has significantly reduced pollution levels and improved regulatory compliance</u>. As the world's first emissions trading scheme (ETS) for particulate matter and India's first pollution trading system, the initiative has also lowered abatement costs, proving the effectiveness of market-based approaches in regions with limited state capacity.

India Launches Athlete Passport Management Unit to Strengthen Anti-Doping Efforts

Union Minister Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya inaugurated the Athlete Passport Management Unit (APMU) at the National Dope Testing Laboratory (NDTL) in New Delhi. This new initiative enhances India's commitment to clean sports by aligning with international anti-doping standards. The APMU will track athletes' biological markers under the Athlete Biological Passport (ABP) system, helping detect doping patterns.

India to Host International Big Cat Alliance Headquarters, Strengthening Wildlife Conservation Efforts

India has signed a historic agreement with the International Big Cat Alliance (IBCA) to host its headquarters and secretariat, reinforcing its leadership in global wildlife conservation. The IBCA, launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in April 2023, focuses on protecting the world's seven major big cat species. This collaboration aims to promote global cooperation for conservation, research, and habitat preservation of these endangered species.

Bhagavad Gita Manuscripts and Natyashastra Added to UNESCO's Memory of the World Register

India has achieved a significant cultural milestone with the inclusion of the <u>Bhagavad Gita</u> manuscripts and <u>Bharat Muni's Natyashastra in UNESCO's Memory of the World Register</u>. This addition acknowledges India's rich intellectual and cultural heritage.

Blue Origin's Historic All-Female Spaceflight Marks a Milestone in Commercial Space Travel

Blue Origin's New Shepard rocket successfully completed a groundbreaking suborbital spaceflight with an all-female crew, the first since Valentina Tereshkova's historic flight in 1963. Launched from Van Horn, Texas, the mission featured six prominent women from various fields, including Katy Perry, Gayle King, and Lauren Sánchez. The 10-minute flight reached the Kármán line, the edge of space, and showcased significant progress in gender representation in aerospace.

New York Proclaims April 14 as Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Day

New York City Mayor Eric Adams declared April 14, 2025, as Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Day to honor the Indian Constitution's architect on his 135th birth anniversary. The announcement, made at a UN event attended by global dignitaries and addressed by Union Minister Ramdas Athawale, highlighted Dr. Ambedkar's enduring legacy in human rights, justice, and equality.

Mohun Bagan Clinches Historic ISL Title at Home
